



## Terms of Use

The Immenhausen Scouting Center is the training center of the Bund der Pfadfinderinnen und Pfadfinder e.V (German Association of Guides and Scouts), yet is open to any other interested group for its activities. The BdP is one of the five major German scout and guide associations recognized by the world scout associations. It is interdenominational and coeducational. The BdP's pedagogic concept is the guiding principle for its activities. Our association is based on the voluntary commitment to common rules and self-organization:

1. I will be helpful and considerate.
2. I will respect others.
3. I will contribute to the friendship of all scouts and guides.
4. I will be honest and reliable.
5. I will be questioning and take responsibility.
6. I will not avoid difficulties.
7. I will get to know nature and help preserve it.
8. I will control myself.
9. I will work for peace and the community in which I live.

In accordance with the BdP's mission statement and its pedagogic concept, we expect the following rules of conduct from our guests:

- Tolerance towards the opinions, culture, and lifestyle of other groups and individuals.
- No hostility and defamation of any kind, agitation, missionary work, or manipulation, especially of young people or children.
- Each group must announce the address and reachability of the chairperson or a speaker of its group.
- No support of extremist associations or parties by groups or their members.
- No toleration of inhuman or discriminating ideas (according to article 3 German Basic Law).
- Resolute stand against any form of abuse as well as against violence as a form of social and political confrontation.
- Extremists of all kinds, whether left-wing or right-wing extremists, anti-Semites or Islamists, are excluded as guests and from all events on the premises of the Immenhausen Scouting Center.

Violations of these criteria may lead to permanent expulsion.
